Dear Judge Andrew J. Guilford, my name is Dianne Neal, I reside in the state of Mississippi, and I am writing this letter to inquire about the settlement and object to the terms of the settlement due to the fact we (my son and I) were not notified or informed regarding the settlement. I feel we were mis-lead and mis-informed about the case. I would like to know if my son and I were considered as plaintiffs or class members in this law suit. Was my case apart of this settlement? Why was the website blocked preventing people from following the case deadlines, and rulings? I have been unable to reach my local attorney who advised me to contact him only regarding this case but seem to be unavailable at all times.

My son and I were told that we were plaintiffs in this lawsuit, we filed our law suit in Jackson, MS two years ago, but my attorney told us that he withdrew the lawsuit in MS and filed in CA because we needed a change of venue. My son and I, have endured a lot of pain and suffering from the harassment of wells fargo, with over two hundred and twenty eight telephone calls, forced CPI insurance on our vehicle, an increase in loan payments, and threats to repose our vehicle. This harassment has caused pain and suffering from asthma attacks, depression, high blood pressure and other health related problems.

It is my understanding that we were mis-lead intentionally in order for others to benefit from our lawsuit, our evidence and proof of wells fargo wrong doing and fraudulent actions shown toward me and my son. My question is why were we not informed of the courts actions? Why was the website blocked, preventing us from following the case? Was my case apart of this settlement? Are we (my son and I) plaintiffs in this lawsuit? And why should we be forced to refile a lawsuit when we were told we are plaintiffs in the lawsuit even though it is a multidistrict class action lawsuit we would continue to have our own suits and remain as plaintiffs. How can one exclude themselves from a settlement if they are not inform of the terms and settlement amounts? How can wells fargo continue to bill me for past due CPI insurance? That's included in my loan, when my automobile has been wrecked?


